<p>What do children need to bring to school?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Water Bottles (Water only, no juice of any kind) • Book Bags must come to school every day. • Reading books and record logs must come to school every day in book bags. 	<p>What should children wear to school?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uniform: unless wearing a summer dress, ties should be worn at all times • No trainers. • No jewellery. • PE: No earrings on Tuesdays. • Long hair tied back. • Please ensure your child wears weather appropriate clothes. 
<p>What are our important days?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tuesday afternoons: PE lessons for both classes. Please ensure your child's PE bag is returned to school at the beginning of each new term. • Friday Morning – Library session. Your child must return their library books every Friday. 	<p>When is homework given out/handed in?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading books will be changed weekly. • Spellings: will be given to your child on Fridays. The Spelling Quiz will take place on the following Friday. • Maths homework will also be given on Fridays. Please bring it back to school after the weekend on Monday. • All routine letters will go home on a Friday. They will be accessible on the school website. The Friday update letter will be emailed to you every other Friday starting on 15.09.17 

Other information:

Please find your child's **Home Learning** on the Curriculum Letter that you will receive each half term. **It is important your child completes their Home Learning and returns it to school by the date on the letter.**
