HOW YOU CAN HELP AT HOME:

Reading: Please continue to read with your child everyday.

TOPIC:

In this topic the children will explore their local area identifying different common animals and discovering what they eat. The children will design their own park using ideas from our visit to Poole Park. We will look at simple maps and use directional language to follow a route around school.

STAYING SAFE:

We will learn about what our 'personal information' is and how we should use it.

MATHS:

This term we will be focusing on learning to confidently read and write numbers from 0-20 and beyond. We will learn how to solve simple addition and subtraction number sentences. We will learn the pairs of numbers that make 10.

LITERACY:
