TOPIC: This term we will be learning all about space. We will look at the planets and how they move around the sun, gravity and how this affects us, as well as a detailed look at the moon and its effects on our tides. This will link into our reading and writing, as we will be creating our own space/sci-fi story! MATHS: We are continuing to focus on improving our reasoning and explaining skills by using images to illustrate our ideas. We will look at a range of maths topics, including measures, statistics, measurement, area, perimeter, volume and algebra.	LITERACY: Our focus this term is on securing the skills and gaps identified through our mock SATS before half term. We are looking at developing our reading skills in summarising, using inference to understand feeling and how writers can use language to describe characters. We will be writing our own sci-fi stories and writing a report on black holes!	RE: We begin the term looking at the Epiphany, and the role of the three kings in spreading the word of Jesus. We will also look at the role of the story for us today. In revelations, we will look at the role of the story of the disciples in our lives today, and for Christianity as a whole.
