Little pleas for help!

- We ask all parents to adhere to our **voluntary 'one-way'** system by entering Sancreed Road via Newlyn Way and leaving via Northmere Road. The road is very narrow and it is impossible for 2 cars to pass with cars parked and makes it extremely dangerous for our children. Thank you for your co-operation.

Staggered School Day

This is to enable the correct amount of meals to be ordered and to cut back on waste. Please book on line using our Parentpay system. Admissions
