Relationship and Sex Education Questionnaire

Relationships and Sex Education is now statutory in all primary schools in England. We are adopting a scheme of learning called 'Life to the Full' by 'Ten Ten resources'. This scheme will be followed by all primary schools across our academy trust and has been approved by our diocese, the Catholic Education Service and the Department for Education.

The education of children in human sexuality is an important, precious and privileged responsibility. The Church teaches us that education is very much a partnership with parents whereby parents are the 'first educators' of their children on these matters.
